

**Instruction to Authors**

*African Journal of Science, Technology, Innovation and Development (AJSTID)* is a multidiscipline journal, which publishes original research covering economics, science, engineering, and technology, but with a focus on the economics of innovation and development. The journal targets policy makers, practitioners, as well as the academic researchers concerned with the impact of science, technology, engineering, mathematics and innovation process on industrial, economic, social and sustainable development, including venture creation, social innovation, economic and social entrepreneurship, innovative engineering, and business management. Contributions detailing novel theories and approaches for engineering innovation for social inclusion and green economy are very welcome. The main focus of *AJSTID* is Africa, but contributions from elsewhere that have implications for all developing economies are encouraged.

The journal publishes full-length papers (up to 8 000 words), research commentaries and research notes (2 500 words), and book reviews (up to 10 000 words) will be considered.

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Submissions must be in two parts: 1) Title page with author details; 2) Manuscript (including abstract) without author details

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Tables and figures (charts, diagrams, photographs) should be presented as separate files and not placed in the main text. They should contain only information directly relevant to the content of the paper. Each table and figure must include a full, stand-alone caption, and each must be sequentially mentioned in the text.
